Six pret-ty maids come and gang one-long o' me to mer-ry green fields in the yard-yard. In 1917, a more recognizable version was published in a collection of World War I-era songs: Old Macdougall had a farm in Ohio-i-o, And on this farm, he had some dogs in Ohio-in-o, With a bow-wow here, and a bow-wow there, Here a bow that a wow, everywhere a bow-wow. The most modern version simply rolls out a variety of barnyard animals with the accompanying sounds, each verse adding the earlier sound to a long string, until at the end of the song, children are mooing, neighing, barking, mothing, quacking, and chuckling. The song can continue as long as the singers have patience and can think of new animals to add to the repertoire.
